Approved exporter; Permit to issue a declaration of origin on a commercial invoice

PCC BakkiSilicon hf, ID no. 450612-0140, has on November 22nd, 2019, applied for a permit to issue a declaration of origin on a commercial invoice, independent from value, on account of the export and customs clearance of silicon metal and silica powder. The company also applied for a exemption from signing such statements.

The permit is hereby issued in accordance with Article 22 of Protocol 4 to the EEA Agreement as well as stipulations of other free-trade agreements that Iceland is party to, except for the free-trade agreement between Iceland and China. The permit is subject to the following conditions:

1. When declarations of origin are being made, the conditions of the relevant free-trade agreement must be adhered to.
2. According to the tax authority's stipulation, the permit holder is obliged to provide information as stated in Article 30, paragraphs 1 and 3, and Article 144 of the Customs Act No. 88/2005, and submits the data and provides the information that the customs authority deems necessary in order to ascertain the veracity of the information contained in declaration of origin.

The permit is effective for five years from the date of this letter. A request for renewal must be submitted before the permit expires; otherwise, the permit will be void on 9 December 2024.

It is to be emphasized that if the permit is abused, or if the conditions above are not fulfilled, it may result in the immediate revocation of the permit, and furthermore, abuse can lead to criminal liability, cf. Article 173, paragraph 1 of the Customs Act No. 88/2005.
